LaunchTime for iOS update is available on the App Store

GUILDFORD, UK - Friday, 15 September 2017 - A new update is available today for LaunchTime. This version supports iOS 11 and the new iPhone devices. Two new features are introduced, users can add launches to their calendar, and enable the app to update launches automatically in the background. LaunchTime was released one year ago, since then a lot of features and improvements has been implemented. I'm looking forward to continue working on it in the following years.

Release notes:

- Updated to iOS 11
- Added 'Add to Calendar' feature, you can add launches to your calendar
- Added background fetch, launches are updated regularly so you won't miss one when its launch date changes
- Bug fixes and improvements

LaunchTime is available for free for iPhone. The update is available worldwide on the Apple App Store.
